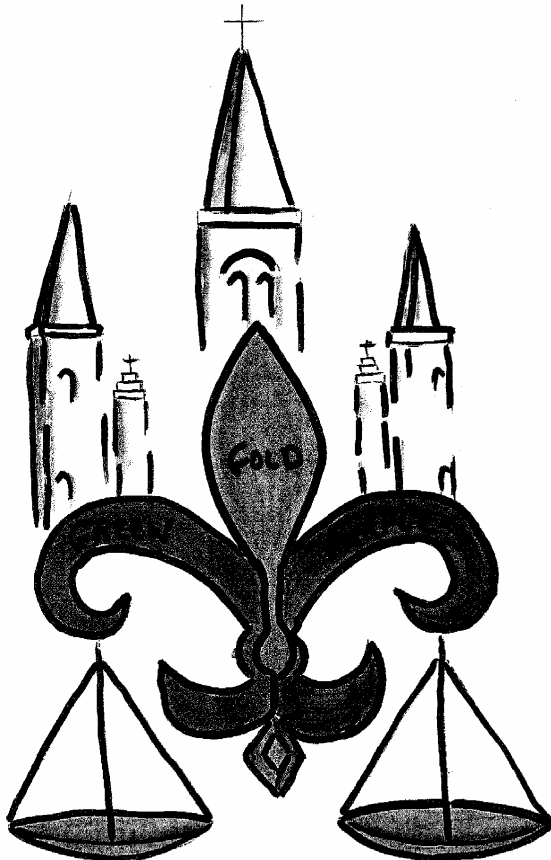

## Back of T-Shirt



*Laissez Les Bons Temps Rouler!*

The design incorporates three symbols. The outline of the St. Louis Cathedral (the oldest Cathedral in North America), which is the recognized symbol of New Orleans, the only city in the world identified by its cathedral. The fleur de lis, representing perfection, light and life, centers the design and is representative of Louisiana's strong French influence. Rendered in the three colors of Mardi Gras, green stands for faith, hope and joy; gold represents power and generosity; and purple signifies justice and royal majesty. Since Katrina, the fleur de lis has represented New Orleans' determination and dedication to recovery. The scales of justice balance the design, representing NCACC's dedication to serving and improving the justice system.

Our famous Louisiana French motto finishes the design by saying it all:  
**Let the Good Times Roll!**
