Debbie Autrey Confirmed to Executive Committee of the National Conference of Appellate Court Clerks

Debbie Autrey, Clerk of the Sixth Court of Appeals at Texarkana, TX, was confirmed to the Executive Committee of the National Conference of Appellate Court Clerks (NCACC).

Autrey was appointed Clerk of the Court in January 2006. She has been employed with the Court for over 33 years. Prior to becoming Clerk, Autrey served the Sixth Court of Appeals in the positions of Accountant, Deputy Clerk, and Appellate Secretary. Autrey has a bachelor's degree in business education from Harding University and an MBA from Texas A&M University–Texarkana. Since becoming a part of the NCACC in 2006, she has served as Chair of the Scholarship and Site Selection Committees and as a member of various other committees.
